Obstacle Points:

Determined by the judge. Each obstacle of greater value than 2 is a “Colour” obstacle, and has a corresponding number cone beside it. Three or four “red” jumps, each of value 1, are also placed strategically in the ring. “Colour” obstacles can also be a combination of obstacles as determined by the judge and marked accordingly.

Opening Points:

The Judge calls out the point number for each obstacle the dog successfully completes. Circle each 1 “Red”, and write each “Colour” number down in Opening Points section. Cross out each unsuccessful 1 and skip the next Colour (as per 202 and 203 examples above). Add all the points together and put this figure in the Opening Points Sub Total column.

Closing Points:

The Judge calls out the point number for each obstacle the dog successfully completes. Circle the number in the Closing Points section. If a dog faults put a line through that number. Refer to the superscript number in the last box circled and put this number in the Closing Points Sub Total column, e.g. if last number circled is 6 then the superscript number is 20; this is the Sub Total.

Course Time: Write the course time the dog has achieved in the Course Time column.

Total Points: Add Opening Points and Closing Points sub-totals together. Write this figure in the appropriate Total Points column.

To Qualify a dog must:

- a) Score equal to or greater than the Opening Points designated for that class, e.g. Excellent = 15 or more points, **AND**;
- b) Successfully complete all Closing Points obstacles (sub-total = 27), **AND**;
- c) Complete the entire course in equal or less than the Judge’s Standard Course Time.

Example for Excellent: Opening Points = 15; Closing Points = 27; example above: Mr Goodjudge’s Standard Course Time = 62 seconds or less
